

From notes taken at San Leon MUD Public Meeting held Wednesday February 20, 2019 at San Leon VFD which was attended by approximately 40 concerned Citizens, standing room only since they ran out of chairs.

- 1) The MUD has now changed their tune in regard to the “FEMA inspired” Galveston County Floodplain Regulations. They now claim that the MUD actions were merely intended to “provide Notice to San Leon Residents of Galveston County’s Regulations” and that the MUD never intended to actually enforce said Regulations.
- 2) The MUD announced at the meeting that a Public Bond Election is scheduled for May 4, 2019 which will involve Debt totaling \$39,650,000.00 (yes that is over 39 MILLION Dollars). That Debt to be paid by San Leon land owners via our already sky high Water Bills and Property Tax. *Voter's Registration Deadline is April 4th. Be Aware of the Facts. Citizens will Vote regarding the MUD on May-4th (or vote early Apr 22-26 and 29-30). (The MUD's Public Announcement regarding the Bonds was NOT on the published Public Meeting Agenda.)*
- 3) Hal Walker, MUD District Engineer, announced that the MUD has been in violation of TCEQ Regulations for the past five (5) consecutive months.
- 4) Election Records obtained from the MUD provided at the Meeting via a FOIA request has turned up irregularities in the in the May-2018 MUD Officers election involving Director Joe Manchaca, Director Tyson Kennedy & Director Kelly Neason. These persons were Elected MUD Officers by virtue of an Election that was CANCELLED. The People of San Leon did not Elect these Officers for their present Position.
- 5) Financial Statements from the MUD, obtained via separate FOIA request, provided proof of HUGE monthly financial losses at the San Leon MUD over the past twelve (12) months.
